



Barry Tam is currently a Trainee Clinical Psychologist in his first year training at the University College London (UCL), UK and iCope-Islington Psychological Therapy and Well-being Service, London, UK. He has a Master\\\'s degree in Paediatric Neuropsychology in UCL where he finished his thesis in infant pain under supervision of Dr Rebeccah Slater. He is active in paediatric and adolescent research and has presented at various international meetings. His scientific interests include the psychopathology of adolescent depression in general, and currently with special focus on the relationship between alexithymia and depression, as well as somatization in adolescents.

Prior to his current training, Mr Tam was a member in Dr Wing Wong\\\'s pain research team and involved in clinical research projects in adult chronic pain. In addition, his thesis \\\\"Prevention for depressive symptoms among adolescents in Hong Kong: A study of enhancing subjective well-being\\\\" won the Outstanding Academic Paper Award by City University of Hong Kong.




