  - The Royal Society (2025-27)

  - Sage (2026-28)



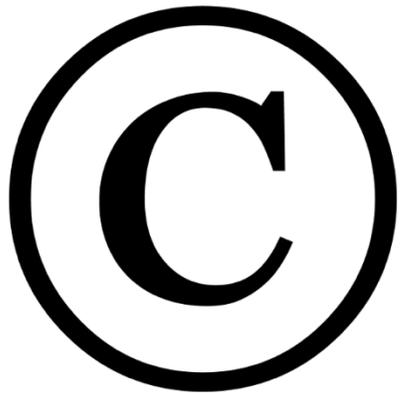
# Artificial Intelligence (AI)

- AI-Powered Research Tools Unconference organized by LSC (1 August 2025)



# Copyright

- Subsidiary Legislation for Specification of Libraries, Museums and Archives and Prescribed Conditions for Certain Permitted Acts
  - **April 2024:** Response submitted to public consultation
  - **May 2025:** Addressed Legislative Council enquiry via IPD on the making and supply of copies of copyright works by JULAC libraries to their users
  - **January 2026:** Subsidiary legislation commenced



# Preparation for RAE 2026

- Coordinating copyright clearance efforts
- JULAC libraries provided support to researchers and departments
