



### Significant Change in Leadership

- A large number of departures and retirements of professionals in JULAC libraries in the past few years
- 5 out of the 8 JULAC Directors were appointed after the last JULAC Libraries Forum in January 2021

- Achievements: As of Dec 2024, there are 13 JULAC Transformative Agreements (TAs) / OA consortiums, with one of them for OA books

# Moving Forward (2/2)

- Preparation for RAE 2026
  - Request publishers to add RAE clause in license agreement of all JULAC consortiums if feasible
  - Confirmed with UGC that the copyright clearance arrangements for RAE 2026 will follow the same practice of RAE 2020 (May 2024)
  - Updated Major publishers list for seeking royalty-free permission on copyrighted publications (Oct 2024)
  - UGC wrote to the major publishers to seek royalty-free permission to use copyrighted publications for the exercise (late November 2024)
